General qualifications include:

- Patience, compassion, confidence, ability to remain calm in crisis situations
- Strong organizational skills
- The ability to respond positively to difficult situations
- Ability to work independently, think on your feet and respond to situations in the moment with confidence
- Basic computer/word processing skills
- Valid driver's license (some transportation required)
- Applicant must be 21 or older, have a clear background check and a negative TB test
- Training will include but not be limited to: Med Management, Universal Precautions, CPR/ First Aid, Mandatory Reporting, Trauma Informed Care

It is helpful, but not required, to have prior experience working with children or in a health care environment.

Program Director - Salary Commensurate with experience - Immediate Opening This individual will oversee the day to day activities of staff and participants including education, health care and organized programming of the girls living in our care. Includes scheduling, outreach, facilities, coordination with care providers, and employee management.
