The Board of Directors of Junior Achievement of Central Iowa, Inc. is seeking qualified candidates for the position of JA Area **President**.

The Board invites resumes from individuals with a record of **demonstrated success** in fundraising, board development, staff management/development, marketing and public relations. A Bachelor's degree (or equivalent business experience) and five years of business or nonprofit leadership experience is required.

The 2015-16 projections include unrestricted revenue of \$839,536 and expenses of \$885,054. Audited results of the 2014-2015 year indicate total unrestricted revenues of \$769,031 and total expenses of \$767,105. Total net assets on July 1, 2015 were \$1,938,103.

Program projections for 2015-2016 include 1,313 total classes, impacting nearly 32,000 students. During 2014-2015, JA of Central Iowa was in 1,317 classrooms, reaching 31,142 student and had a market share of 15.65% in its 27 county territory.

In addition to the President, there are 2 full-time and 5 part-time employees.

JA of Central Iowa provides a local benefits plan which includes health, dental and term life insurance and participates in the JA USA pension plan. Salary is dependent upon experience.
